What's New in Version in 2.1.1

The 2.1.1 release of the NeedToMeet Outlook Add-in resolves several issues discovered since the release of the 2.1.1 version and adds several new features.

- The ability to populate the To field in a new meeting poll request by selecting contacts in the Outlook Contacts view has been added. (2446)
- An issue where the grid view of the My NeedToMeet Meeting window was compressed when viewed at 200% has been resolved. (6236)
- An issue where the calendar timeline view of the My NeedToMeet Meeting window was not correctly scaled when viewed at 200% has been resolved. (6238)
- An issue where the status bar of a meeting window was very small when viewed at 200% has been resolved. (6240)
- An issue where the To list box of the New NeedToMeet Meeting window was compressed when viewed at 200% has been resolved. (6242)
- An issue where the new email form ribbon was not correctly scaled when viewed at 200% has been resolved. (6246)
- The NeedToMeet Configuration Wizard now includes the ability to check your contacts for NeedToMeet users and then grant permission to your availability to found users and/or request permission to their availability. (11297)
- An issue where the To field of a single attendee, private response meeting was blank after receiving responses has been resolved. (13272)
