# What's New in Version in 2.1.3

The 2.1.3 release of the NeedToMeet Outlook Add-in resolves issues discovered since the release of version 2.1.2, and adds new features.

## Release Notes 2.1.3

- The "Private" option has been removed from the *Default Calendar Access* drop-down list (in *Calendar Settings*), since the setting denied access only to new contacts, and was not applied retroactively to existing contacts, and it is unlikely someone would want to add new contacts without also providing some access to the calendar. Instead, calendar access for any particular contact can be disabled in the *Contacts View*, by setting *Calendar Access* to *None*. (15776)
- On-screen notes for the *Calendar Settings* screen have been updated to note the scope of settings that determine how much of your calendar data can be seen by others. (In *General Calendar Settings*, event Subjects and Locations can be made visible only to others polling for NeedToMeet meetings, not for native Outlook meetings.) (15775)
- In a manual sync of contacts, the *last synchronized* date/time (on the *Meeting Setup and Contact Synchronize* screen) now updates correctly. (15767)
- NeedToMeet now automatically updates the *Personal URL* value (in *Account Settings*) if the *User Name* value is changed. (15766)
- When selecting available times for a new meeting, and browsing the calendar in the *Week* view with *Show Weekends* enabled, the right scroll arrow now correctly scrolls to future dates as expected. (15310)
- When creating a new NeedToMeet meeting with zero invitees, the *Copy meeting link to clipboard* feature now omits the "select=1" portion of the URL from the copied string, so the website no longer prompts you to select names from an empty list. (15141)
- Setting up *Contact Permissions* no longer generates an error if your personal address book contains no contacts. (15134)
- NeedToMeet no longer automatically syncs contacts every day if *Synchronize Frequency* (in *Account Setting Options*) is set to *Manual syncs*. (14293)
- Alerts associated with a contact are now deleted if the contact is deleted. (14285)
